Dear Parents,

I would like to thank you for attending the Year 8 Parents' Consultation Meeting and giving valuable feedback to improve our education and welfare provision at NLGS.

I understand that a few parents have raised their concerns about noise during some lessons. Some students in year 8 are going through a change of attitude this year which is causing some lesson disruption. This is not acceptable and we will not tolerate such behaviour as it disturbs the concentration and learning process for the rest of the class.

We have a robust behaviour policy and procedures in place. We ask our teachers to follow these procedures and be firm and consistent. We have the support in place for our new teachers but unfortunately some students will not give them the chance to adapt to our school.

I would like to inform all parents that we will deal with the noise issue in Year 8. The form tutor with all the SLTs are constantly working together to resolve this problem.

The following stages of sanctions will be implemented to tackle any disruption:

1. 2 warnings and time out
2. if continued, 2 weeks' yellow report
3. full day isolation when daily targets are not met during the length of the report
4. parents will be called in for a meeting if the same behaviour continues after isolation
5. finally, red report and fixed term exclusion.

I do not expect that we would need to reach level 5 but it is important for all students to know what will happen to them if they continue to cause problems in class.
